I'm writing to say how delighted we were to have you as guests at our first Hebridean Dark Skies Festival this month, along with your astronomer colleague Amaury Triaud. It was fascinating to hear about the Creativity and Curiosity project and to see some of the beautiful, evocative work you've created. It very much summed up the spirit of a festival which is very much about finding interesting meeting points between the arts and astronomy.

I was pleased to hear your own observation that it was unusual for your project to be showcased in an arts centre rather than in a more scientific context. This is something that a few people have picked up on – the only events I can think of that are similar to ours are Edinburgh International Science Festival (which as you'd expect is mostly focused on science but with some arts content) and Bluedot, which is obviously held at Jodrell Bank Observatory.
